## **UPDATE #15 – DETAINER HEARINGS**

Friends:

Some properties have started receiving notices for detainer warrant hearings. <u>As</u> of today, these are the first dates counties are setting hearings for detainer cases:

Anderson County Blount County Hamblen County Knox County Loudon County Roane County Sevier County June 1, 2020 June 1, 2020 August 11, 2020\* May 12, 2020 July 2, 2020\*\* May 29, 2020 May 11, 2020

## THESE DATES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

(\*) Cases already set in Hamblen County for May 5, 2020 will still be heard that day.(\*\*) Cases already set in Loudon County for May 28, 2020 will still be heard that day.

For <u>conduct</u> evictions, we are attempting to secure earlier dates where possible. However, at this time it appears the earliest court date for ANY eviction will be in May. The details of how these proceedings will take place are still being worked out. The courts are aware that the reopening of their courtrooms must be done in a manner that will limit exposure to Covid-19. As additional details become available for each of the courts, we will let you know.
