City of Knoxville Housing Assistance Program
for City of Knoxville Residents

Friends:

The City of Knoxville has created a COVID-19 Housing Assistance Program designed to assist renters who are unable to pay their rent either because they have lost employment due to the coronavirus, or because they have been diagnosed or quarantined with coronavirus and are unable to work.

This assistance is available to residents in the city of Knoxville who are not otherwise receiving public housing assistance through KCDC or a Section 8 voucher. The program can help with current rent and past due payments from April 2020 forward. The money is paid directly to the landlord on the resident's behalf.

Information for interested residents is available by calling 2-1-1. The Landlord Portal on our website, painetarwater.com, also has some materials on the program from the City of Knoxville, including the answers to Frequently Asked Questions.

We hope this information is helpful to you and may provide some financial relief for your tenants.
